



Eurovision Village

In 2025, the Eurovision Village will take place indoors for the first time, in Hall 1 of the Basel Exhibition Centre. The Messe und Congress Center Basel is located in the heart of the MesseQuartier and, with over 141,000 m² of exhibition space, is one of Europe's most important exhibition and congress centres and an outstanding venue for the supporting events of the Eurovision Song Contest 2025. It hosts the world's most important art fair, Art Basel, as well as over 250 congresses and other events every year.

Daily stage programme

The Eurovision Village offers a daily programme of live concerts, public viewings, food and drink stands and other activities related to the Eurovision Song Contest. The programme in the Eurovision Village will be hosted by Tanja Dankner, Odette Hella'Grand and Joël von Mutzenbecher.

Opening hours: 10 to 17 May 2025, daily from 12 noon to around midnight.

Location: Messe Basel, Halle 1 – in the heart of the MesseQuartiers

Admission: Free admission, there are security controls.

No bags are allowed in the Village.

The hall is divided into three zones:

1. **Activation zone**

The first section features spectacular activation stands from the official Eurovision sponsors.

2. **Village core zone**

The heart of the village is the perfect place to hang out: food trucks offer food from all over the world, there are regular live concerts on the Village Stage, and bars cater to your physical well-being.

3. **Event zone**

The rear area of the Village is where the party happens! Eurovision delegations and former ESC stars will perform on the Main Stage. On 13, 15 and 17 May, you can watch the Eurovision Song Contest here for free.

Things to discover in the Eurovision Village

- **LoveCloud**
The LoveCloud rises up in the middle of the village – a 32-metre-long installation made of balloons that is transformed into a glowing, pulsating work of art by projections.
- **Jukebox Dancer**
Kilian Haselbeck brings his interactive dance performance Jukebox Dancer to the Eurovision Village in Basel. Inspired by a jukebox, spectators can select dance styles at the touch of a button, which Kilian then performs at lightning speed – from ballet to rock. The performance celebrates diversity, identity and artistic freedom and fits perfectly into the ESC supporting programme.
